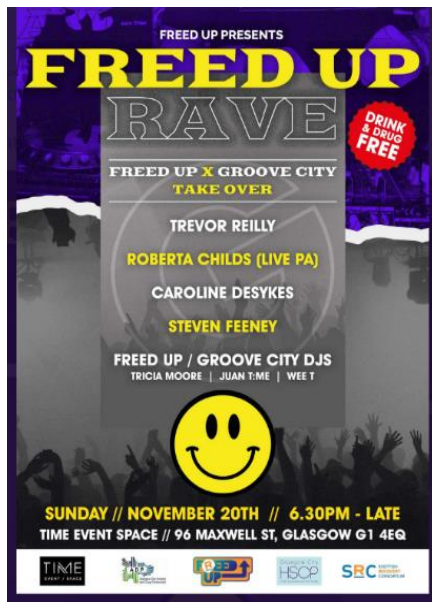


### YMCA

## **Funding**

### **Corra**

This fund aims to support direct work with children and families affected by alcohol and drugs. We are seeking applications that are based on partnership approaches which demonstrate how they will take a Whole Family Approach which is Relational and Rights-Based when delivering front-line services which support children and families.

The Improvement fund will support drug service resources, with a particular focus on supporting organisations which deliver residential rehabilitation and associated services. This fund aims to support projects which provide fast and appropriate access to treatment and care, and that support people by taking a rights-based and whole family approach. This means the fund is prioritising applications which relate to:

- Increasing Residential Rehabilitation provision and capacity will be the top priority
- Recovery Housing and Aftercare will be the second priority
- Supportive pathways into Residential Rehabilitation will be the third priority
