News

Scottish Drugs Forum's Addiction Worker Training Project

Trainees on Scottish Drugs Forum's Addiction Worker Training Project graduated from the programme in an event at Glasgow City Chambers on the 28th of June.

The graduates included three local trainees who participated in the programme with funding from North Lanarkshire ADPI. In total nineteen trainees from across Scotland completed 9 months of on-the-job training and working towards an SVQ2 in Health and Social Care. Each trainee received a range of other training and practical experience of working in placement in local services. They were awarded with certificates at the ceremony presented by Drug and Alcohol Policy Minister Elena Whitham MSP.



North Lanarkshire ADP are delighted to congratulate all three trainees on completing the course and wish them all the best in their future careers. This year, 4 new trainees with join the Addiction Worker Training Project from North Lanarkshire with continued funding from NLADP and the Scottish Government.

Human Rights Bill for Scotland

The Scottish Government <u>has published a consultation on proposals for a new Human Rights Bill for</u> <u>Scotland</u>. The Public Consultation will run for 16 weeks, closing on Thursday 5th October 2023.

MAT Standards – National Benchmarking report

Public Health Scotland published a national benchmarking report in June this year. This set out progress made in implementing the Medication Assisted Treatment standards across Scotland. Standards 1 to 5 were assessed across all 29 alcohol and drug partnerships. Of 145 standards of care assessed, 17% (25/145) are fully implemented, 65% (94/145) are partially implemented and 18% (26/145) are not implemented.
