



IMPROVEMENT ACTIONS FROM DRD REVIEWS

- Monitoring of length of time between prison liberation and DRD to explore potential of an assertive pathway led by commissioned services
- Evidence of joint working between Addictions and Justice Services
- Evidence of NFO pathway being in place
- Evidence of assertive outreach approach if individual has recently disengaged from services
- Evidence of family involvement in individual's care plans
- Identifying any gaps in individual's care journey
- Identifying any public protection concerns prior to individual's death

DRUG DEATH REVIEW GROUP UPDATE

- The Lanarkshire Drug Death Review Group is currently reviewing the DRD review process.
- Updated review forms have been developed and agreed by the group members and discussions around Information Governance and Information Sharing are continuing.
- Evidence Based Strategies for Preventing DRDs and MAT Standard Recommendations have been incorporated into the DRD review process



Of the 37 suspected DRDs, **15** individuals had previously experienced a NFO



Of the 37 suspected DRDs, 15 had been supplied with Take Home Naloxone

NALOXONE

- 380 naloxone kits distributed
- 81 staff trained, 88 clients
- 37 naloxone saves reported
- 37/86 NFOD had been issued naloxone
- 4 naloxone used in NFOD before SAS arrived
- 46 Naloxone administered by SAS
