Minimum Unit Pricing (MUP) Reduces Deaths and Hospital Admissions

On 21st March 2023, Public Health Scotland (PHS) and The Lancet published new evidence showing the impact of alcohol minimum unit pricing (MUP) on deaths and hospital admissions attributable to alcohol consumption. The study estimated a 13.4% reduction in deaths, and a 4.1% reduction in hospital admissions, wholly attributable to alcohol consumption following the implementation of MUP.

Cambridge University Press published an Article "Substance use, risk behaviours and well-being after admission to a quasi-residential abstinence-based rehabilitation programme: 4 year follow-up." The results included "Abstinence rates improved from 12% baseline to 48% at 4 years, with the rate for those completing the programme increasing from 14.5% to 60.7%.
